# CHECKLIST FOR MANAGERS/TEAM ADMINISTRATORS

# Required

- 1. Register for the tournament: <u>10U-12U (link)</u> | <u>13U-14U (link)</u> | <u>15U-18U (link)</u>
  - a. Pay the full entry fee (\$1365) and you're in! You are good to go and can work on booking your hotels and preparing to take part in this memorable event.
  - b. OR you can choose to pay the deposit (\$700) first and the balance at a later date no later than June 23 (Week 1&2) and July 1 (Week 3). This will hold your spot in the event and the balance due will remain in the cart of your USSSA account.
- 2. Abide by the tournament's Stay to Play requirement: Reserve a minimum of 20 room nights per team (Ex: 5 rooms for 4 nights or any combination) through the tournament's lodging partner, HBC Event Services. <a href="mailto:usssa1hotels.com">usssa1hotels.com</a> or call 505-346-0522. OR Select accommodations outside of HBC (house rental, condo, etc.), and pay the housing opt-out fee (\$900 per team) <a href="https://www.wicosports.org/housing-opt-out">https://www.wicosports.org/housing-opt-out</a>
  - a. Email Robely Rivera at <a href="mailto:rrivera@wicomicocounty.org">rrivera@wicomicocounty.org</a> with an exemption request if you are a local team, commuting daily, or whose players all have their primary residence within 60-miles of the tournament. Secondary, seasonal and vacation homes do not qualify for exemption.
- 3. Enter your team roster online at www.usssa.com.
- 4. Attend the Manager's Check-In and Meeting, bringing with you:
  - a. Two copies of your signed roster to the Manager's Check-In (must have all player and parent signatures)
  - b. Two copies of your proof of insurance certificate

## Optional:

- 1. Submit forms for any additional options:

  - c. Discounted Attraction Tickets: Will be sold online for a limited period leading up to the tournament and during manager's check in and throughout the week at HPAC Stand 1. Link coming soon!
  - d. Practice Fields 9 a.m. 4 p.m. Fields allotted in 1:45 increments for \$25. Payment is due at Manager's Check- In. For the Salisbury area, contact Jerry Mears at <a href="mailto:imears@wicomicocounty.org">imears@wicomicocounty.org</a>.





## **ONLINE ENTRY**

The Eastern Nationals has a single-entry fee with an option to pay a deposit to hold your place in the event. This can be managed through your USSSA account. There are no Gate Fees.

To participate in the tournament your team must complete the online entry through www.usssa.com

- 1. Pay the full entry (\$1365) OR
- 2. Pay deposit (\$700) which will hold your spot in the tournament. Pay the balance remaining in the cart of your USSSA account at later date. Full balance of the entry fee is June 23<sup>rd</sup> for Weeks 1 & 2 and July 1<sup>st</sup> for Week 3.

Your registration is subject to approval by your state director. Early online entries are encouraged as there may be a maximum number of teams that can be accepted for each age and class division.

The official team roster posted on the USSSA website shall be the only roster in effect for the event. Any changes to your roster may be subject to state and/or national director approval.

All players participating in USSSA Fastpitch youth tournaments shall have proof of age in possession of their team manager at all times. Proof of age must be verified by a government issued document that identifies the player by name, gender and birth date.

- \*Refunds cannot be issued after the deadlines listed above.
- \*Checks are NOT accepted. All entries must be completed and paid online.

## STAY TO PLAY HOTEL REQUIREMENT

USSSA works through HBC Event Services to secure a wide variety of lodging partners. All out of town teams must book their rooms through HBC Event Services, or follow the housing opt-out instructions below. Only a minimum of 20 room nights per team is required (Ex: 5 rooms for 4 nights or any combination.) Please note, if you book a stay directly with a hotel or with a non-partner hotel, you will not be stay to play compliant. <a href="mailto:usssa1hotels.com">usssa1hotels.com</a>

### **HOUSING OPT-OUT**

We recognize that a variety of housing options exist, so an opt-out fee offers an alternative. After paying the opt-out fee, your team can stay wherever they would like (ex: non-partner hotel, vacation home, condo, campsite, etc.). The fee is \$900 (or about \$75 a family, based on a roster of 12). Any team not booking the minimum of 20 room nights through HBC Event Services is responsible for paying the opt-out fee in order to remain eligible for the tournament

Local teams, commuting daily, whose players all have their primary residence within 60-miles of the tournament can email Robely Rivera at <a href="mailto:rrivera@wicomicocounty.org">rrivera@wicomicocounty.org</a> with an exemption request. Secondary, seasonal and vacation homes do not qualify for exemption.

Opt-Out Fee Deadlines: June 23<sup>rd</sup> for Week 1 & Week 2 and July 1<sup>st</sup> for Week 3. Refunds will not be issued after the deadlines listed above. Refunds may be issues prior to stated deadlines less a \$25 processing fee. No refunds will be issued after stated deadlines.

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

## **Tournament Headquarters**

Henry S. Parker Athletic Complex (711 W Naylor Mill Road, Salisbury, MD 21801) Other parks within the Salisbury/Ocean City area will be used as needed.

\*Daily park assignments for each age/class bracket will not be known until the event and are always subject to change.

## Park Rules and Details

- No metal cleats on turffields.
- No admission is charged at park entry to players or guests, as it was included in your tournament entry.
- Regular-sized coolers are permitted. Teams are responsible for supplying their own beverages in the
  dugout. No alcohol permitted. Any non-water item (sunflower seeds, Gatorade, etc.) is prohibited in
  the dugouts on turf fields.
- Grills and open flames are not allowed; concession stands are available.
- Pop-up tents are allowed as long as they do not impede tournament function. Every park has covered dugouts.
- Pets are permitted, but MUST be leashed. Owners will be asked to remove any pets making a nuisance.

#### Rainout Line

Weather related announcements will be communicated through a dedicated Rainout Line. The phone number is 410- 220-0050, or you can download the free app. It is imperative that your team utilizes this line. ## Rules

All playing rules shall be governed by the official USSSA Fastpitch softball rulebook and national by-laws. The rulebook online, at <a href="https://www.usssa.com">www.usssa.com</a> will always supersede the latest printed version if a discrepancy exists.

## Softball & Bats

The tournament ball will be USSSA stamped approved, yellow leather cover, .47 cor. All bats must bear the current USSSA stamp with a manufacturer's stamp of 1.20 BPF and must be in accordance with the current year's regulations.

#### Metal Cleats

Metal cleats are NOT allowed on turf fields. Fields 5-8 at the Henry S. Parker Athletic Complex are turf infields. Please make sure that your team is prepared to play on these fields and has proper footwear (turf shoes, molded cleats, etc.).

### **Awards**

The full-size package that will be awarded for divisions with *more than 32 teams* consists of team trophies to the top six teams, individual awards to the top six teams, team sportsmanship award, outstanding pitcher award, outstanding offensive player award, outstanding defensive player award & MVP award. Divisions with 32 teams or less will have a reduced awards package. In the case of a division having a split bracket, both brackets will have the applicable awards package.
