USSSA Space Coast Complex Policies

Manager/Coach Tickets:

Each tournament packet will have three (3) stapled packets of coach's passes. There is one (1) ticket per day in each stapled bundle. At the gate, show your ticket for that day and the gate staff will put that day's-colored wrist band on your wrist. The ticket is now nullified after it is scanned, and the wrist band is what allows you to re-enter for that day. If you lose your wristband, you will be asked to pay for entry.

Outside Food and Drink:

The complex does **NOT** allow any outside food or drinks into the complex.

Coolers:

<u>Team Cooler</u>: Each team is allowed one (1) cooler with water, ice, and towels ONLY. An event band for team coolers is required and will be distributed at the manager check-in. Teams will not be allowed to bring in coolers unless it has the cooler band attached. Any team who attempts to bring in any outside food and beverage other than water in the team cooler will no longer be allowed to use a team cooler.

<u>Individual Players:</u> are permitted one (1) personal water jug up to 74 oz in size and one (1) small cooler with ice and towels ONLY (size of lunch box)

Spectators: are permitted to one (1) small cooler (lunch box size) with water, ice, and towels only **OR** a 32 oz cup.

Lightning:

<u>Lightning</u> – One (1) long horn will sound throughout the complex indicating there is lightning in the area and to seek shelter. If in SC Stadium, spectators may go to the concourse and players and coaches may stay in the brick dugouts. Spectators and players anywhere else in the complex must return to their vehicles during the lightning delay. **DO NOT STAY IN THE QUAD DUGOUTS!** When the all clear is issued you will hear three (3) long blasts throughout the complex.

Cashless Complex:

<u>The complex is cashless</u>. This includes at the ticket gate, concessions, and the pro-shop. We highly encourage buying tickets ahead of time and having them on a mobile device rather than purchasing them at the gate through a QR code on your mobile device.

Cleats:

<u>ALL AGES – NO METAL CLEATS.</u> Only plastic/molded, turf shoes, or tennis shoes in the complex. All fields/mounds are turf!

Warmup Space:

Batting cages (6) near the SC Stadium are first come, first serve. Please be respectful of other teams and utilize a reasonable amount of time if other teams are waiting. Areas behind temporary fences on fields may be used as warmup space unless stated otherwise by a director. It is also a courtesy to check with coaches that are in a game to make sure they are okay with your team warming up while they are playing. No one other than players and coaches are permitted in this area. **DO NOT HIT INTO THE FENCES!**

Streaming/Recording:

No recording devices or any objects of any kind can be attached to, hung from, or fashioned in any other way into any netting at the complex.

Speakers/Music:

Speakers are allowed for walkup songs and warmup music if the music is clean and free of vulgarity. If the volume level is too loud, staff will ask it to be turned down. If the occurrence happens a 2nd time the guest will be asked to put the speaker in their vehicle. Please be respectful of other fields around you regarding volume.



Noise Makers:

Artificial noise makers of any kind are **NOT PERMITTED** in the complex. Please leave horns, bells, cow bells, rattles, drums, washboards, etc in your vehicle.

Pets:

Pets are welcome at our complex if they are always leashed and are cleaned up after by their owners. **PETS ARE NOT PERMITTED** on field turf!
